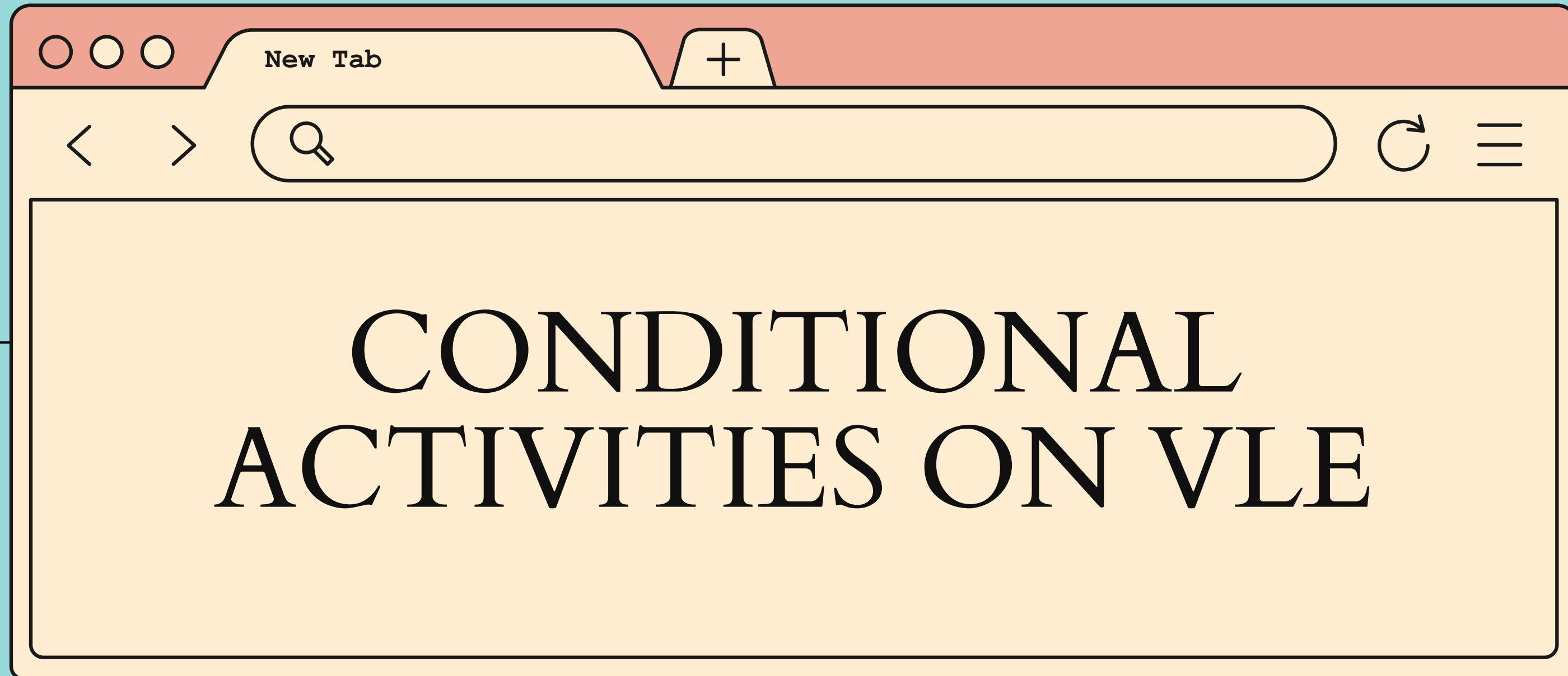

Conditional activities enable teachers to restrict the availability of any activity according to certain conditions such as dates, grade obtained, or activity completion.

When it is enabled by the administrator, a "Restrict access" setting appears in the settings of activities or resources.

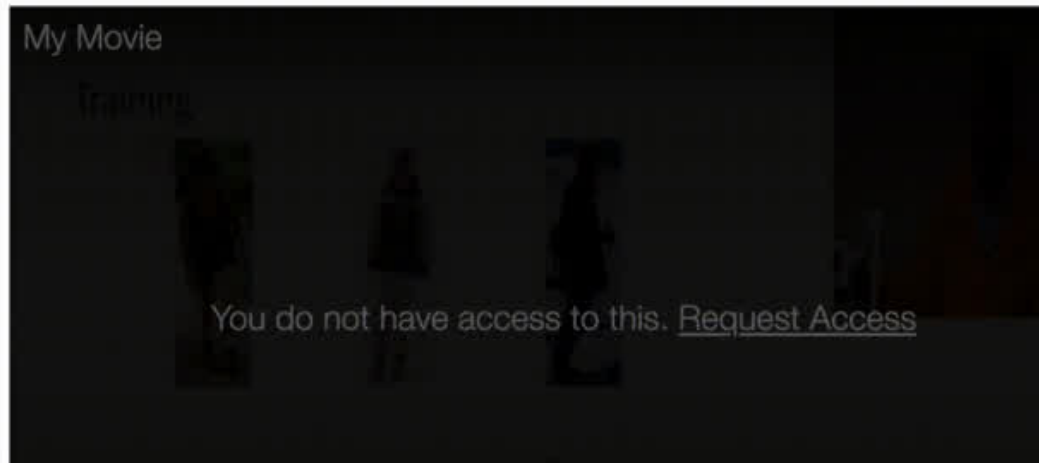

The 'Add restriction...' dialog box contains the following options and descriptions:

Restriction Type	Description
Activity completion	Require students to complete (or not complete) another activity.
Date	Prevent access until (or from) a specified date and time.
Grade	Require students to achieve a specified grade.
Group	Allow only students who belong to a specified group, or all groups.
User profile	Control access based on fields within the student's profile.
Restriction set	Add a set of nested restrictions to apply complex logic.
