

Extemporaneous SpeechAssignment Guide

Objective

Demonstrate credibility and persuasiveness in a prepared speech

Task

This requirement expects you to present a clear motion and to discuss it in a video recorded speech.

Procedure

- 1. Think of a topic that you are passionate about. Narrow down the specifics of this topic and situate it in the local setting (e.g., dress code narrowed down to imposing a dress code among students of state universities in the Philippines).
- 2. Create a motion about this topic, which can be a fact, a policy, or a value motion.
- 3. Before preparing and recording your speech, you should have your motion approved. Send your proposal to submissions.morada@gmail.com with the subject SP133 EXTEMPO SPEECH MOTION APPROVAL. Include your motion and a 2-3-sentence description. Checking of proposals will be on October 6, 8 AM to 5 PM ONLY. I will no longer approve proposals beyond this.
- 4. Once your topic has been approved, prepare your speech. Present the field and presumption on the issue being discussed.

- 5. You should have three main arguments to support your motion. Present your motion in the introduction, your 3 main arguments in the body, and your summary and call for action (if any) in the conclusion.
- 6. Record yourself performing the speech. Make sure that the frame captures the upper half of your body.
- 7. Deliver your speech in a professional yet conversational manner. Avoid a dramatic or informal style of speaking.
- 8. Your video-recorded speech should only be 5-7 minutes long.

Submission

 Submission will be at the designated dropbox in our Google Drive folder on or before October 19, 11:59 PM.

Assessment

The extemporaneous speech will be graded 100 points, with the breakdown below:

Content – 60 points

Command of the topic throughout the
speech; alignment of arguments with the
motion; evidence-based reasoning

Organization – 15 points

Clear IBC; flow and transitions are
smooth and enhance appeal and
persuasive power of the speech

Delivery – 15 points

Good posture, appropriate gestures, and

other nonverbal behaviors that enhance the

speech

Language – 10 points *Diction, pronunciation, eloquence*
