# **Operating Room Duty**

- Observe or assist in operations
- Responsibilities
  - Know the Operating Room schedule the day before, ideally assist cases in the GS services that you are assigned to
  - Prepare histopath request forms if needed
  - Perform procedures if the surgeon allows

#### Reminders

- Bring your own scrub suit, OR shoes/slippers
- Two lockers are available for Clerks' use (just ask from the RCB info/desk and leave your ID)
- Introduce yourself to the primary surgeon and inform him/her that you are going to observe or assist
- Familiarize yourself with the procedure/operation to be performed (prior to scrubbing in)

# **Emergency Room Duty**

 Participate in the management of Non-COVID ER patients together with the Surgeon on Duty(SOD)

#### Responsibilities

- Do history taking, and PE
- Suggest diagnostics and therapeutics
- Perform procedures under supervision
  - IV insertion
  - Blood extraction
  - NGT, foley catheter insertion
  - Suturing
  - Wound care
- Reminders
  - Wear proper PPEs
  - Clerks are allowed a 1 hour break in between the duty

## Ward Duty

- Coordinate with your GS Teams (Create or join their Viber/Telegram group)
- Assign SIC patients
- Responsibilities
  - SIC Notes
    - Complete history and PE for all NEW patients of the service (INITIAL)
    - Incoming Notes/Progress notes for all OLD patients of the service (DAILY)
    - Use RADISH (take a screenshot and send to the Team Captain)
  - Procedures (with supervision), wear appropriate PPEs if performing procedures
    - IV insertion
    - Blood extraction
    - Foley Catheter Insertion
    - Wound Care and Dressing
- o Join Team Rounds

### **General Reminders**

- Report DAILY to UPM BESTS
- Hand hygiene
- Avoid crowding/maintain social distancing
- Limit patient contact to less than 15 mins
- Eating together is HIGHLY discouraged
