Rating scale: 3 = significant contribution to discussion 2= some participation 1= hardly any participation 0 = no participation
GROUP RATING
Rating scale: 3 = expected of a well prepared student / answered most question 2 = minor deficiencies 1 = major deficiencies / unprepared 0 = did not contribute to discussion
1. Quality of questions asked to gather clinical history data
2. Requested appropriate physical exam data
3. Identification of the salient features of a case
4. Analysis of data to arrive at a diagnosis
5. Included relevant medical condition in the differential diagnosis
6. Decision to request for lab exams
7. Decision to request for a referral
8. Identification of the problems of the patient : biomedical
9. Identification of the psychosocial problems of the patient
10. Presentation of the pharmacologic management
11. Presentation of the non pharmacologic management
12. Presentation of an appropriate preventive care plan
