

VIDEO CASE PRESENTATION GUIDE

WORK-BASED ASSESSMENT

Task

After exploring several materials on the various work-based assessment methods, you are tasked to choose a partner and create a 10-minute presentation of a case sample, an actual unit of instruction or training program that utilizes an assigned work-based assessment method in their clinical teaching. The case sample should feature the chosen assessment method and how it was implemented within their setting. These cases could be searched from the internet or from actual experiences in your own or other institutions.

Procedure

1. At the beginning of the semester, you were asked to choose from five topics you would like to create a case presentation for. The topics include:

- a. Observation using DOPS
- b. Observation using Mini-CEX
- c. Case-based discussions
- d. Multisource feedback
- e. EPA

2. Study the materials included in the Study Guide for Work-based Assessment for your chosen topic.

3. For that specific assessment method, look for a sample case of a clinical teacher or institution who is using that assessment for their instruction. The sample cases can be culled from literature in reports or journal articles, from blogs or videos posted in the internet, from experiences of colleagues, or from your own personal experiences. You are free to decide how best this can be presented- through actual demonstrations, interviews, images, or narratives.

The presentation should include the following:

- a. a brief description of the chosen work-based assessment – include a description of the strengths and limitations and minimum resource requirements
- b. description of the case
- c. your analysis of the usefulness of the assessment based on the experience from the case presented

You are free to use any presentation format, but make sure that the final output is a video of the presentation which should not exceed 10 minutes. Save your outputs in mp4 format following file name: HP223_CP_[surname]_[month day submitted]

4. Share your video in the course site.



5. Watch the other presentations and provide comments to the video in the course site. Be sure to comment on all the videos.
