



Family Case Study Rubrics: **Priority-Setting**

Criteria	Indicator	Yes	No	Remarks
Nature or condition of the problem	<u>Correctly categorizes</u> the problem as health deficit, health threat, wellness situation or foreseeable crisis or stress point			
	<u>Describes the extent</u> to which the vulnerable member is affected by the health condition or problem in terms of physical or behavioral health status			
Modifiability of the problem	<u>Identifies</u> whether current knowledge, technology or interventions are available or accessible to address the condition			
	<u>Describes</u> whether the family has physical, financial and manpower resources to correct the condition or problem			
	<u>Describes</u> whether the nurse and other health providers possess knowledge, skills and time to address the health problem or condition			
	<u>Identifies</u> presence of health and health-related facilities, agencies or organizations in the community that can be tapped for support			
	<u>Relates</u> the different factors to ascertain the extent to which the problem can be minimized, alleviated or eradicated			
	<u>Determines</u> the gravity or seriousness of the problem in terms of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Progress of the disease • Prognosis 			
Preventive potential	<u>States</u> the duration of the problem			
	<u>Describes</u> whether the problem is being addressed and whether the management is appropriate			



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	<u>Identifies</u> family members who may be vulnerable or at risk of being exposed to the condition			
Salience	<u>Assesses</u> family's perception of the problem or condition in terms of importance or the need for immediate action			

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
