Family Case Study Rubrics: Priority-Setting

Criteria	Indicator	Yes	No	Remarks
Nature or condition of the problem	<u>Correctly categorizes</u> the problem as health deficit, health threat, wellness situation or foreseeable crisis or stress point			
Modifiability of the problem	Describes the extent to which the vulnerable member is affected by the health condition or problem in terms of physical or behavioral health status			
	Identifies whether current knowledge, technology or interventions are available or accessible to address the condition			
	<u>Describes</u> whether the family has physical, financial and manpower resources to correct the condition or problem			
	<u>Describes</u> whether the nurse and other health providers possess knowledge, skills and time to address the health problem or condition			
	Identifies presence of health and health-related facilities, agencies or organizations in the community that can be tapped for support			
	Relates the different factors to ascertain the extent to which the problem can be minimized, alleviated or eradicated			
Preventive potential	 Determines the gravity or seriousness of the problem in terms of: Progress of the disease Prognosis 			
	States the duration of the problem			
	Describes whether the problem is being addressed and whether the management is appropriate
