1.	Health Problem Statement	<u>Correctly categorizes</u> the health problem as wellness condition, health deficit, health threat, foreseeable crisis/stress point			
		<u>Identifies</u> the affected or at risk/vulnerable family member/s			
2.	First level assessment	<u>Identifies all</u> significant and critical cues to define the health problem guided by the Typology of Nursing Problems in Family Nursing Practice			
		<u>Uses different sources</u> of data to generate cues to establish the problem			
		Performs cross-referencing and cross validation of data			
		Sorts or clusters all related data			
		<u>Compares findings</u> to normal or standard values			
		Interprets findings			
		Identifies gaps in the data that need to be collected or validated			
3.	Second- level assessment	<u>Correctly describes</u> the family's level of performance of the health tasks guided by the Typology			
		<u>Identifies all</u> relevant cues to establish the problem			
		<u>Describes patterns of behavior</u> of family that may explain the family's failure to perform the health task
