Course Title : Theory Building

Course Description:

Analysis of philosophies, theories, principles, and research findings in nursing science and related fields to provide structure in nursing theory development applicable to practice.

Course Goal: The expected outcome is an explanatory framework of a substantive theory in nursing, health, and caring.

The course consists of 2 parts:

a) study of the underpinnings of the discipline of nursing by examining its philosophies, theories, concepts, principles, research findings, and nursing development in the country,

b) engaging in the nursing theory development process.

Course Learning Outcomes:

- 1. Explain an evidence-based approach/ method in the analysis and synthesis of the nursing science- related philosophies, theories, principles, research findings in an integrative review form.
- 2. Develop an explanatory framework of a substantive theory in nursing, health, and caring, through:
 - a. Concept analysis process
 - b. Systematic organization of the linkages between and among the concepts (or variables).

c. Generation of theoretical relationships, propositions, and empirical indicators.
