Selection of	<u>Determines</u> specific nursing interventions that are

	adequate and comprehensive to address the problem			
	Developmental intervention/client teaching

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	Care management/collaborative/coordinative/provider of care		
	Identifies the role/s that the nurse will assume in the provision of care to the family		
Developing a plan to evaluate nursing interventions	<u>Describes</u> the expected health outcomes or behavior changes to be observed over a certain period of time		
	Specifies the criteria how the health outcome or behavior will be measured or observed		
	<u>Decides</u> on the standards or the expected level/degree of performance based on objective realities of the family
