Activity 1: PSYCHIATRIC ASSESSMENT AND INTERVIEW

Duration: 3 hours

Learning Outcomes:

- 1. Establish trust and rapport with the client
- 2. Use effective communication strategies in the conduct of psychiatric assessment
- 3. Assess client's mental health status (brief psychiatric history and mental status exam)
- 4. Ensure privacy and confidentiality during client interaction
- 5. Document psychiatric nursing assessment findings

Instructions:

- Review the strategies in psychiatric interview and the conduct of psychiatric assessment.
- Each group should assign the following:
 - Interviewer: Psychiatric History
 - Interviewer: MSE
 - o Documenter/Reporter
 - Observer
- You will be given 45 minutes to interview a patient (actor) in an assigned room.
- Manage your time wisely. After 45 minutes, the documenter will report to the faculty in a charge all the significant findings elicited during the interview using the psychiatric assessment form provided.
- Faculty will then give feedback and comments to be followed by processing of the experience and lessons learned. (30 minutes)
- After the small group discussion, everyone will return to the main session for big group sharing (c/o assigned observers per group) and synthesis.
