

## EVALUATION TOOL FOR FPC PRECEPTORIALS

CRITERIA
<p><b>RATING SCALE of 1-5:</b>            1 - Major deficiencies, needs improvement            3 - Satisfactory, with some minor deficiencies            5 - Outstanding, no deficiencies</p>
<p><b>CLINICAL HISTORY: The student must have given the following information about the patient:</b></p>
1. General data, profile of the patient and chief complaint
2. Sequential narrative of the history of present illness
3. Past Medical and any current comorbidity and how it is being managed, including medications and status
4. Family history with genogram of household
5. Personal and social history, lifestyle
6. Psychosocial context of the patient – personal thoughts and feelings, expectations and impact of current medical problem; family context if relevant to medical problem
7. Immunization history
8. Review of systems
<p><b>PHYSICAL EXAM FINDINGS:</b></p>
9. Vital signs, anthropometrics and general survey
10. Head and neck
11. Chest and cardiopulmonary
12. Abdominal exam
13. Extremities, musculoskeletal exam and skin findings
14. Any special exam indicated because of patient's medical problem (ex. neurologic exam)
<p><b>WORKING DIAGNOSIS:</b></p>
15. Identified the main medical problem of the patient pertinent to the main reason for consultation
16. Identified other problems patient may have, if any
<p><b>PROPOSED MANAGEMENT:</b></p>
17. Diagnostic tests requested
18. Pharmacologic intervention
19. Nonpharmacologic intervention
20. Preventive care recommendations
21. Referrals, if indicated
