Nursing 12 Public Health Nursing I Study Guide: Days 4-5

How did you find the topic last week? Assessing a family's health status may be quite different from the usual health status assessment of individuals in terms of breadth and depth. As a family health nurse, you are expected to assess all the members of the family, and that fact alone, may drain all the energy you have, especially if the family is a big one. In addition, you have to describe the family's structure, characteristics and dynamics, home and community environment, socio-economic and cultural characteristics, and values and practices on health promotion, wellness maintenance and disease prevention. All these have influences in how the family will perform their health tasks. The ultimate goal of family health nursing is to assist the family and its members in strengthening their competence in performing their health tasks towards improving their health status. It is in this context that this week's topic become important for you. You need to develop a nursing care plan that is responsive, appropriate and relevant to the needs of the family and its members.
