Checked the patient's chart			
Verified patient's identity and consent			
Checked the patient's weight, if stated in the chart			
Checked pre-medication, if applicable			
Introduced self to patient			
Checked if anesthesia machine is in proper working order			
Checked suction			
Checked patency of patient's IV lines			
Checked airway equipment			
Checked that laryngoscope is in proper working order			
Prepared tape to secure the ET tube and inflator for the ET tube cuff			
Attached monitors (as applicable) to the patient and verified that these are functional			
Checked drugs			
Supplemental drugs, e.g. sedatives, opioids (as applicable)			
Induction agents			
Muscle relaxants

Preoxygenated patient with 100% oxygen			
Administered drug in proper sequence

Positioned patient properly for laryngoscopy			
Inserted laryngoscope smoothly using left hand			
Swept tongue to the left and repositioned patient as appropriate to visualize vocal cords			
Inserted endotracheal tube smoothly using the right hand			
Auscultated chest for the presence of equal breath sounds and verified correct tube placement			
Secured ET tube
