Guidelines for Presentation of Rapid Appraisal Results and Initial Problems Identified

- I. Rapid Appraisal shall begin on September 17, 2024 (Tuesday) and initial results shall be presented on September 24, 2024 (Tuesday).
- II. Each section shall prepare a **15-minute presentation**. No specific limits for the number of slides and number of presenters.
- III. In conducting your Rapid Appraisal and presenting your results, be guided by the [Windshield Survey PDF](#) uploaded in VLE. Also be guided by the following components in organizing your content. Each group shall discuss how to appropriately sequence the following based on your findings:
 - a. Include the 3 parts discussed in the abovementioned PDF: **Community Core History, Subsystems, and Perceptions**
 - b. Include multimedia documentations (e.g. photos, videos, as appropriate)
 - c. Create a **spot map**. Identify boundaries and landmarks. Include important areas (e.g. barangay hall, health center, market, school, church, basketball court) as they are situated in relation with their proximity to residential houses and other significant establishments. A sample spot map of [Barangay Obo, Dalaquete, Cebu](#) is shown. You may also visit [this link](#) for another sample.
- IV. Since our community diagnosis shall be **problem-focused or population-focused**, initial results shall also include:
 - a. Initial problems identified (e.g. stunting, disaster risk) and rationale
 - b. Initial population to focus on (e.g. adolescents, 0-5 years old, senior citizens) – Rationalize your choice. You may look into characteristics, such as their vulnerability, magnitude of health needs, or strategic value to your community health nursing process.
- V. Be ready to **respond to questions or clarifications** from the class and the faculty.
- VI. **Take extra care** in conducting your rapid appraisal. **Enjoy the learning journey!**
